## Grosmont:

Grosmont, our 1952 style British Railway station, is home to the engine sheds where our locomotives get some well-deserved restoration, partly funded by proceeds from the Shed Shop. It's also the junction with the main rail network, and home to one of our traditional tea rooms serving hot and cold lunches.

## Esk Valley and Battersby

Every effort is made to operate all trains with steam unless otherwise advertised. On the light green timetable it may occasionally be necessary to operate the first train from Pickering and the last train from Whitby with heritage diesel traction between Pickering and Grosmont/Grosmont and Pickering.

**Newton Dale Halt** All trains call at Newton Dale Halt by request except for the 09.00 from Pickering and the 17.30/18.00 from Whitby. Northbound trains call 9 minutes after leaving Levisham, and southbound trains 13 minutes after leaving Goathland. If you wish to alight here please advise on-train staff as soon as possible after you have joined the train. To board you will need to give a clear hand-signal to the driver as the train approaches.

**Northern Rail services** Times shown in italics are connecting diesel railcar services operated by Northern Rail and are subject to change. These trains DO NOT run on Sundays (except as shown in the Silver Summer Sunday Timetable). NYMR tickets can be used on these trains but accommodation is limited. Other Northern Rail trains also operate between Grosmont and Whitby and from/to Middlesbrough, including a summer Sunday service from 23 May to 12 September. With a 'Day Rover' Ticket, you can travel all day and stop off at as many stations as you like.

Under fives travel free. You can also buy a range of tickets - singles and returns - from stations along the line.

Dogs are welcome on all our trains, and bicycles can be carried - as long as there's enough space for them. Tickets are £2 each, per bike or per dog.

**Fares may be subject to change during special events.**

**1st Class Service is available on some trains, with an additional supplement of £3 per person per single journey payable to the Guard or ticket inspector.**

## Accessibility and Facilities

We're able to take both pushchairs and wheelchairs on our trains. A dedicated coach is also available on some services. Just let us know what kind of help you need.

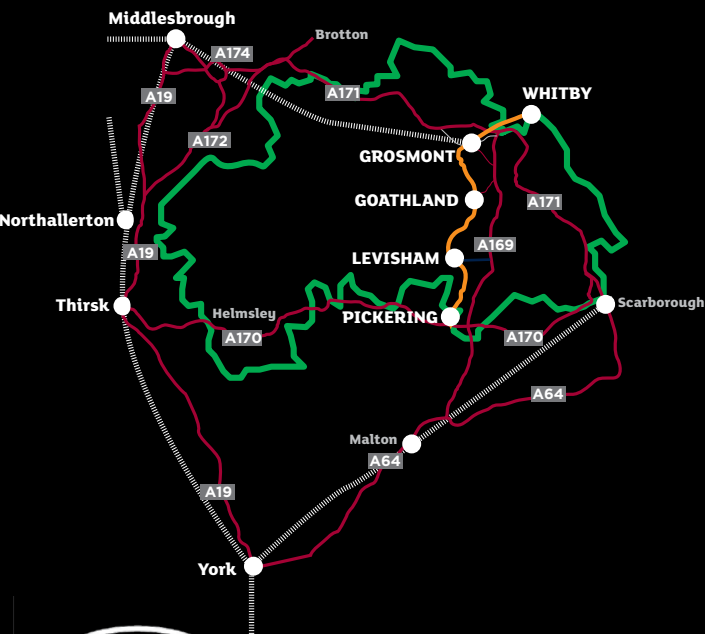
When trains are in or closely approaching Goathland it is only possible to change platforms via the footbridge. Please allow ten minutes before the train is due to depart if you need to use the level route to get to the platform for Levisham and Pickering trains.

There are public toilets at all our stations. Pickering and Grosmont stations provide accessible toilets for the disabled. All stations, apart from Levisham, have baby-changing facilities.

## Car parking

Parking is available at all our stations except Newton Dale Halt. Early arrival is recommended at Pickering due to limited space, although there are several other car parks in town. For those with satellite navigation systems, the postcodes for our principal stations are YO18 7AJ for Pickering and YO22 5QE for Grosmont.

## Take Care

Our trains are fully operational – this isn't just a museum on wheels! Because of this, we ask you to take extra care when travelling:

- Never open the doors or touch the handles when the train is moving
- Keep your fingers away from the door hinges
- Don't lean out of the windows
- Be careful as you disembark – mind the gap!
- Don't stand too close to the edge of the platform
- Keep a special eye on children (and over-excited adults!)
- As with all railways, never walk on or near the track
