I.	NYMR Dry White - 12.5 % Vol <i>Sauvignon Blanc – Volandas, Chile. A generous gooseberry nose with fresh flavours of citrus, apples and peaches.</i>	£14.95
2.	NYMR Medium Dry White - 13 % Vol <i>Chardonnay – Volandas, Chile – Unoaked Chardonnay, pale yellow with aromas of pineapple and papaya.</i>	£14.95
3.	Mosel Riesling “Blue Bottle” – Germany – 9 % Vol <i>A super Mosel, floral and fragrant yet delicate in character. Traditional Riesling at its best.</i>	£14.95
4.	Arcano Pinot Grigio - Italy – 12 % Vol <i>From the sunny hills of the Veneto region, rich, ripe grapes produce Arcano Pinot Grigio. It is fragrant, fresh and crisp</i>	£15.85
5.	Running Duck Chenin Blanc/Sauvignon Blanc - South Africa – 12.5 % Vol (Fairtrade & Organic) <i>The Chenin provides the guava fruit character on the nose and the Sauvignon Blanc the body, length and slight grassiness on the taste.</i>	£17.50
6.	Brown Brothers Everton White – Australia – 13 % Vol <i>Light straw in colour, with pear, stone fruit and tropical fruits with a refreshingly juicy finish. A blend of Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Grigio and Chardonnay.</i>	£17.25
7.	Three Choirs Coleridge Hill – England – 11 % Vol <i>A crisp dry white wine with the gentle aroma of nettles and elderflower.</i>	£19.25
8.	Rosendale Sauvignon Blanc - New Zealand – 12.5 % Vol <i>Rich in fruit aromas of ripe gooseberries, citrus fruits, red capsicums and passion fruit.</i>	£22.75
9.	J P Chenet Colombard/Chardonnay (25cl) – France – 11.5 % Vol <i>Clear and bright, very pale yellow with green lights. Notes of white pears, peaches and vanilla.</i>	(2 glasses per bottle) £5.95

10.	R H Phillips White Zinfandel – California – 11 % Vol <i>Zesty flavours of strawberry, cranberry and watermelon, with grassy tones, and tropical floral aromas dominate. Sweetness combines with a crisp finish to make this wine a perfect aperitif.</i>	£17.95
11.	Chevalier Rose Brut – France – 12 % Vol <i>Attractive salmon colour, fine bubbles. Intense red-fruit aromas. Fresh mouth, elegant and balanced with a good length.</i>	£20.25

12.	NYMR Red - 12.5 % Vol <i>Merlot – Volandas, Chile – Ruby red with cherry aromas. Soft, elegant and rounded and full bodied.</i>	£14.95
13.	Kleindal Ruby Cabernet – South Africa – 14 % Vol <i>Ruby Cabernet is a cross between Cabernet Sauvignon and Carignan. It is full bodied yet soft and easy drinking.</i>	£15.95
14.	Brown Brothers Everton Red – Australia – 14.5 % Vol <i>This medium-bodied red wine is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec and Shiraz. A crimson colour with lifted aromas of blackberries, cherries and hints of delicate oak. The palate is rich with berry fruit flavours, a juicy rounded mouth feel and fine persistent tannins</i>	£17.25
15.	Vega del Rayo Seleccionada Rioja – Spain – 12.5 % Vol <i>A delicious modern Rioja with a deep colour and ripe plum and cherry fruit aromas. Richly flavoured with bags of fruit and a smoky, spicy dimension from six months in oak. Brilliant quality, a real crowd pleaser.</i>	£17.75
16.	Urban Malbec – Argentina – 14.5 % Vol <i>The nose is full of ripe fruit and the mix of damson, bilberry and bramble give a complex mix of flavours to the palate. Supple and fleshy in the mouth there is some mid freshness slightly lightening the weight towards the back and giving the finish a more elegant feel.</i>	£19.75
17.	Cousino Macul Cabernet Sauvignon Antiguas Reserva – Chile – 14 % Vol <i>Dark ruby, this Cabernet Sauvignon displays refined fruit aromas of blackcurrant and black plum backed up by fragrances of violets and spices. Full-bodied and supple in the mouth, it offers a melange of Maipo Valley flavours- blackberry fruit with lovely touches of rosemary, mocha and light oak spice. Balanced and harmonious, it has fine-grained, smooth tannins that carry through to a long finish.</i>	£23.65
18.	Fleurie, Albert Bichot – France – 13 % Vol <i>It is bright cherry red. Fruity and delicately floral. A well constituted wine from the most famous of the Premier Cru Beaujolais sites.</i>	£26.50
19.	J P Chenet Cabernet/Syrah - France – 13 % Vol <i>Ruby red, intense in colour. Notes of cherries, Blackcurrants, green peppers, liquorice and spices.</i>	(25cl - 2 glasses per bottle) £5.95

20.	Louis Roederer Brut Premiere Champagne – France – 12 % Vol <i>From the makers of Cristal. A golden colour with fine bubbles and a nose of fresh fruit and hawthorn. Smooth, complex palate mingling flavours of apple and pear with blackberries, raspberries, cherries and notes of toast and almonds. A pleasurable wine, deliciously smooth and mature.</i>	£42.25
21.	Mountbridge Sparkling Brut – Australia – 11 % Vol <i>A very refreshing, easy drinking champagne style pale straw in colour, showing an attractive, lifted herbaceousness on the nose and fresh fruit flavours, finishing clean with delicate, creamy mouth feel and a crisp finish.</i>	£19.95

22.	Brown Brothers Orange Muscat & Flora – Australia – 10.5 % Vol <i>Orange Muscat is the flavour powerhouse, bringing aromas of orange blossom to the nose and a fresh citrus zest to the palate. While Flora, with its nuances of ripe apricot, contributes colour, texture and mouth-feel to the palate.</i>	½ Bottle £17.75
