## Attractive carriages

Allow us to introduce to you the Great Western Saloon. Originally built in 1948, this carriage has two luxurious seating areas at either end, with fine furnishings and observation windows. It has its own kitchen, toilet and guard's compartment. Guests are self-contained.

This saloon carriage is ideal for smaller parties and can accommodate a maximum of 26 guests.

Alternatively, you may find the Great Northern Saloon to be of interest. This carriage has more intimate seating areas and is complemented by a board-room size table for formal or informal catering. It also has its own kitchen and toilet and can accommodate up to 16 people. This saloon carriage was built at the Doncaster works in 1909. It can be attached to additional carriages and has a through-walkway.

## Small or large groups welcome

Our third saloon carriage is known as the Ryedale Bar. This carriage was built in York in 1936. As its name suggests, it has a charming bar area with informal seating, but is complemented by a more formal seating and table arrangement, complete with table lamps and armchair seats.

This carriage can be hired on its own, ideally for a group of up to 16 guests or it can be attached to the Great Northern Saloon to form a two-coach arrangement, providing even more capacity for up to 32 guests in total with a through walk-way between the two carriages.

Finally, we are delighted to draw your attention to our Pullman train. This provides a magical setting for large groups of up to 109 guests. Pullman was the last word in elegance in days gone by and on this train you and your guests will be seated in lavishly decorated carriages as befits the brand.
