### Friday 1st June 2012 - Textured felt inspired by the Prehistoric Rock Art of the North York Moors

This felt making workshop draws its inspiration from the prehistoric rock art of the North York Moors, which includes spirals, cups (hollows) and rings carved into the surface of rocks over 4,000 years ago. Under the expert guidance of felt maker Jackie Lunn you will produce a piece of textured felt inspired by this art form.

### Wednesday 25th July 2012 - Hollow seamless vessels inspired by rocks and seeds

Learn to make three dimensional hollow forms inspired by rocks and seeds from the landscapes of the North York Moors. Under the expert guidance of Jackie Lunn you will produce at least one hollow vessel.



### **Course Fee**
